Newington Cemetery was opened in 1846, and covers 14 acres. Not only the final resting place of many local families, it also provides a refuge for wildlife and a peaceful haven for visitors.



You are welcome to wander around and discover the cemetery's hidden treasures for yourself or ask one of our volunteers to point out some of the many interesting graves, architectural features and beautiful trees.

- ❖ **Nature trail activities for children and their parents and/or grandparents will be running throughout the afternoon.**
